The Resource Conservation & Development (RC&D) Councils are local people working together to solve local problems and to help their local communities grow and prosper.

The purpose of the RC&D program is:

- to accelerate the conservation, development and utilization of natural and human resources;
- to foster economic and community growth and development; and
- to enhance the environment and standard of living of all Alabama citizens.

There are 9 RC&D Councils across Alabama, and many provide funding for conservation education projects such as Habitat Learning Lab development at area schools. The grant amounts vary widely from \$250 to \$5,000 or more.
