



Frog & Toad Habitat Maintenance Checklist

Below are the supplies/tools needed to complete each maintenance task along with an estimated cost, an estimated amount of time needed to accomplish each task, and the frequency each task should be done.

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE TIPS				
Pull weeds, litter and general clean out of the habitat. Scan the QR Codes on the plant ID signs to learn what the plant species look like to help you avoid removing any host plants.	Hand Shovel and Gloves	n/a	5-10 minutes	Once
Keep the bog watered. Never let the bog soil become completely dry.	Soaker Hose or Garden hose	n/a	10-30 minutes	Once
Late Summer				
Remove diseased plants. Contact your Extension office for advice. www.aces.edu/counties/	Gloves & Pruners	n/a	30 min	Once
Fall				
Divide and share bog and pond plants if overgrown.	Hand Spade or Small Shovel	n/a	30 min - 1 hour	Once
Replace dead perennials if needed.	Hand Spade, Small Shovel	Plant costs Vary	1 hour	Once
Water any new plants for 4-6 weeks.	Garden hose	n/a	20 min	Twice per week
Late Winter				
Prune woody shrubs if necessary. Do not prune spring blooming plants which may have buds.	Gloves and Pruners	n/a	1 hour	Once
Spring				
Plant new annuals and/or replace dead perennials.	Hand Spade and Plants	Plant Costs Vary	30 min - 1 hour	Once
